## **Development Officer – Female Cricket (DOFC) position and organization information.**

### **Background:**

Canterbury Cricket Association are a well-established, passionate and growing organisation focused on developing the game at both a community and professional level. Canterbury Cricket achieve this by working with and investing in our District/Sub Association throughout the Canterbury region. The philosophy in our community game is now about ensuring the participants are enjoying their cricket experience. We aim to achieve this by educating, supporting and developing the extensive network of volunteers, coaches, officials and team managers around the region. Formats, length of games, team numbers and pitch lengths in the junior grades have all been modified to maximise the participants experience, new youth initiatives are being tested and more mid-week adult options are being developed. The game is changing to accommodate the needs of all participants in society today.

### **Opportunity:**

Canterbury Cricket are seeking an energetic, vibrant and passionate Development Officer for Female Cricket (DOFC) to join the Canterbury Cricket Community Team on a fixed term full time contract. This role will be based at the Canterbury Cricket Office on Hazeldean road, Christchurch, and include regular travel around the region.

The objective of this role is to find and recruit the young woman in our communities that are not currently engaged in cricket, then provide them with an enjoyable cricket experience. This role will focus on activating the 10 – 14 age group, in secondary schools, church groups, youth groups and events around the region. Each week the DOFC will run a Community Hub in four locations around the region with support from the local cricket club or District Association coach and activation staff. This is a National programme where NZC and Canterbury Cricket are working in partnership to achieve strategic objectives with an aligned focus on Women and Girls Cricket.

Ideally this position is a full-time fixed term contract, with working hours to cover evenings and weekends when required. Canterbury Cricket would consider applications for part time hours for the right candidate. Cricket specific training and activation techniques will be provided by NZC and Canterbury Cricket. If you have experience in activating young people, working with volunteers and are interested in providing a fun, modified cricket format for female participants then we want to hear from you. Applications close Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> November at 5.00pm.
