

## GET CREATIVE WITH CANTERBURY CRICKET #DESIGNYOURSHIRT

### COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

#### Competition Overview

1. The Canterbury Cricket Association (CCA) are running a competition where sports fans across the country have a chance to design their own shirt which will be worked into a real-life design by Dynasty Sport. The winner will be given one shirt, with the rest used for players and promotional purposes.
2. Competition entrants are deemed to have accepted and agreed to be bound by these terms and conditions upon entry into the competition. If under the age of 18, entrants should check with their parent or legal guardian that they are happy for the entrant to enter the competition.

#### Entry Process

3. The competition will be open from 12pm Monday 24<sup>th</sup> August 2020 and run to 12pm Friday 11 September 2020. Entries received outside this period will not be valid and included in the competition.
4. To enter, entrants should print and template which can be found on the CCA Website page here - <https://www.canterburycricket.org.nz/news/get-creative-with-canterbury-cricket/> and submit the completed design to [marketing@canterburycricket.org.nz](mailto:marketing@canterburycricket.org.nz) with all the contact details completed. Entrants may also design online and submit in the same manner.
5. The competition is free to enter. No purchase is necessary.

#### Eligibility

6. This competition is open to all residents within New Zealand of any age.
7. By entering the competition, entrants confirm they are eligible to do so and can claim any prize they might win.
8. There is no limit to how many times an entrant can enter

#### Prize

9. There will be one overall winner of the competition and the prize for that winner will be their winning shirt design, signed by local Canterbury athletes.
10. The valid competition will be judged on the following criteria, creativity, inspiration, originality and boldness.
11. Five finalists will be selected Friday 10<sup>th</sup> September at 2pm with the overall winner announced Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> September.

#### Claiming the Prize

12. The decision of the judging panel is final. No correspondence or discussion will be entered into regarding the competition.
13. CCA will contact the winner as soon as reasonably practical, using the email or phone number provided on the competition entry.
14. The winner will be presented their prize live at a Super Smash fixture at Hagley Oval (dates to be advised). If the winner cannot make it to the fixture, the shirt will be couriered to the winner within 10 days of that fixture taking place.

### **Ownership of competition entries and Intellectual Property Rights**

15. All competition entries and any accompanying material submitted to CCA will become property of CCA on receipt.
16. By submitting a competition entry, all entrants agree to assigning to CAA all intellectual property rights
